Acct Type – A single digit number indicating the type of account.

- 1 Cash account
- 2 Margin account
- 3 Short account
- 5 Futures
- 6 Repos and fed funds
- 7 Non-purpose loan

Equity Trade- B/S field character indicators

- 1. B/S = B, account type = 1 or 2, Buy
- 2. B/S = B, account type = 3 Buy Cover
- 3. B/S = S, account type = 1 or 2, Sell
- 4. B/S = S, account type = 3, Short Sell
- 5. B/S = C, account type = 1 or 2, Cancel Buy
- 6. B/S = C, account type = 3, Cancel Buy Cover
- 7. B/S = T, account type = 1 or 2, Cancel Sell
- 8. B/S = T, account type = 3, Cancel Short Sell

Mkt/Cap – A two-digit combination of market and capacity code.

Capacity codes

- 1 As agent.
- 2 As principal, not a market maker.
- 4 As agent for both buyer and seller.
- 5 GTC order. Produces a confirm with today's trade date, no settlement date, and the trailer CONFIRMATION OF OPEN ORDER. Appears on the customer activity the day the order is entered and is deleted that night.
- 6 As principal market maker.
- 7 Reversal of commission, as agent. Reverses the front and back commissions. A broker/dealer must be entered on the front side.
- 9 As principal on the floor.
- A Third-market trade.
- C As agent trading in money market securities. Reflects trades run as agent for the issuer.
- D As agent trading in money market securities. Reflects dealer placement trades run as agent. Used when a customer account buys from an

inventory account.

- I As agent trading in money market securities. Reflects dealer placement trades run as agent. Used when an inventory account buys from a customer account.
- P Primary bankers acceptance trading. Reflects principal trades involving customer participation in specific acceptances. The system automatically allocates loan numbers from an inventory on a first in, first out (FIFO) basis.
